SECO Watching Tropical Storm Ida

SECO personnel are carefully monitoring the progress of Tropical Storm Ida. As Ida moves into the Gulf of Mexico the forecast tracks generally have it making landfall along Florida's west coast.

It does not appear that Ida will have a major impact on our area beyond some possibly heavy rain and light winds. Nevertheless, the SECO Storm Center will be carefully watching the developing track of the storm and any deviations in intensity.

The Co-op will be ready to deal with any problems or damage that might be associated with this tropical storm.
